This resource has been specifically selected to help support their learning and preparation for the upcoming Maths SATs.

Some of our pupils had the opportunity to test it today and shared that they thought it was brilliant and easy to use. The great news for you as parents is that the programme **instantly marks and analyses the completed tests**, so all you need to do is encourage your child to set aside some time to log in and have a go.

While there is no pressure for pupils to use it, we are finding that the independent practice is both enjoyable for many of our pupils and extremely beneficial in helping to settle any worries or anxiety they may have about the upcoming SATs. The more prepared they feel, the more at ease they will be when the actual tests take place in May.

We truly appreciate your ongoing support and the positive feedback we have received so far. The decision to provide this online learning has been made in response to requests and discussions during the parent drop-ins last half term, so we hope this will be a helpful resource for your child. For those who prefer paper practice- don't worry we will send some of that too!
